# About

**The Hitachi Young Leaders Initiative (HYLI)** reflects Hitachi's long-term commitment to Asia. Established in 1996, HYLI is a regional thought leadership and social contribution programme organised by Hitachi with the aim of helping Asia identify its future leaders by providing a platform for bright university students. With this initiative, four of the best and brightest university students from each participating country meet to discuss current regional and global issues. They also exchange views with prominent speakers who are the Asian leaders of today, representing governments, business and academia.

Since its inauguration in Singapore in 1996, HYLI has offered over 400 students the unique opportunity to broaden their outlook while promoting Asian values and cross-cultural understanding. At every HYLI, up to four student delegates are handpicked by the selection panels in each of the eight (8) countries, namely Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

**The theme of HYLI 2024 is "Greening Together: Inclusion & Sustainability."** This year's edition featured four final presentations by the students, each focusing on a critical aspect of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs): (1) Good Health & Wellbeing (SDG 3), (2) Affordable & Clean Energy (SDG 7), (3) Reduced Inequalities (SDG 10), and (4) Sustainable Cities & Communities (SDG 11).

## Visit to Nusa Penida Microgrid

The delegates will visit the microgrid in Nusa Penida and gain hands-on insights into hybrid solar power plant. Operated by Indonesia Power, the microgrid has been deploying latest state-of-the-art technology of Hitachi Energy and providing clean energy to more than 10,000 homes and numerous tourists resorts, supporting Indonesia's energy transition.

The visit will include a detailed exploration of the solar panels integrated into the microgrid system, demonstrating how solar energy is harnessed and distributed to support local communities. This session will highlight their commitment to sustainability and enhancing quality of life, encouraging active participation and exploration of opportunities in sustainable energy.

## Delegates Presentation

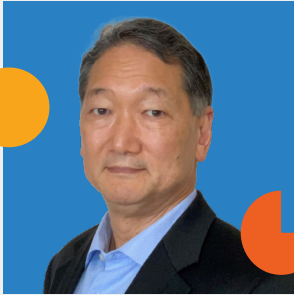

Following this role, he moved to the Embassy of Japan in the Islamic Republic of Iran, serving as Counsellor for Political Affairs from February 2014 to August 2016.

In August 2016, Mr. Ueda was appointed as the Director of the Hague Convention Division at MOFA, and in September 2017, took on the role of Director of the Terrorism Preparedness and Response Division. His expertise continued to be recognised with the appointment as Director of the Second Southeast Asia Division, overseeing relations with Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, and Timor-Leste from August 2019.

In August 2021, Mr. Ueda was named Director of the Aid Policy and Management Division in the International Cooperation Bureau, where he managed Japan's foreign aid policies. Most recently, in September 2023, he became the Minister for Economic and Development Affairs at the Embassy of Japan in Indonesia, continuing to contribute to Japan's foreign policy and international development efforts.
